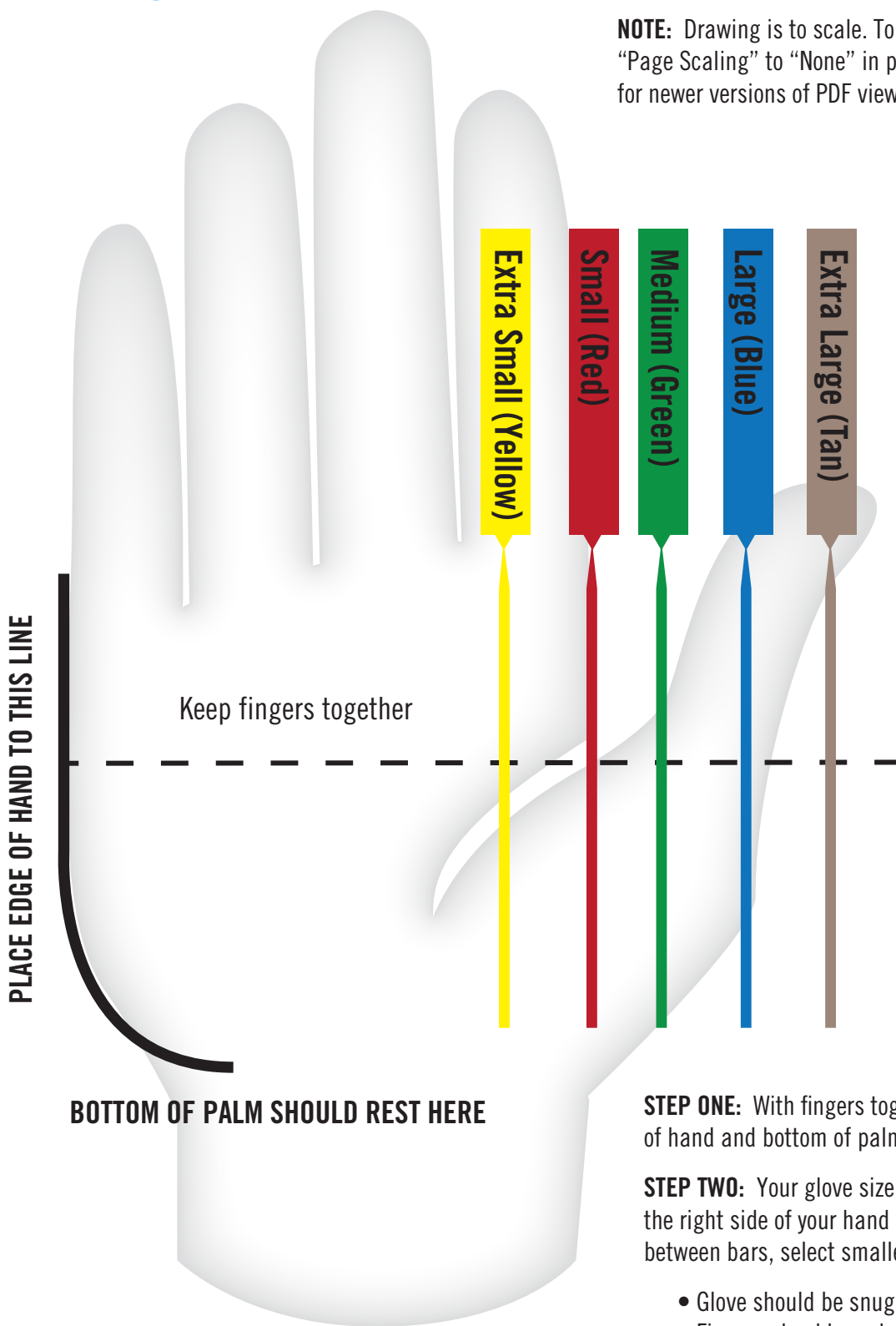


# Sizing Guide for KutGlove™ Cut Resistant Gloves

**NOTE:** Drawing is to scale. To prevent scaling when printing, set "Page Scaling" to "None" in print dialog box or check actual size for newer versions of PDF viewers.



Hands come in all shapes and sizes. A one-size-fits-all approach is simply ineffective. **Correct fit is very important!** It not only reduces risk of injury, but also ensures a longer product life cycle. Workers are also more likely to wear a glove that fits properly and doesn't slow them down.



Gloves should be cleaned and sanitized regularly. (See washing instructions.)



**STEP ONE:** With fingers together, place hand so that left side of hand and bottom of palm rests on black line.

**STEP TWO:** Your glove size is determined by the color bar where the right side of your hand rests. If the side of your hand falls between bars, select smaller size.

- Glove should be snug, not tight.
- Fingers should reach completely to the end.
