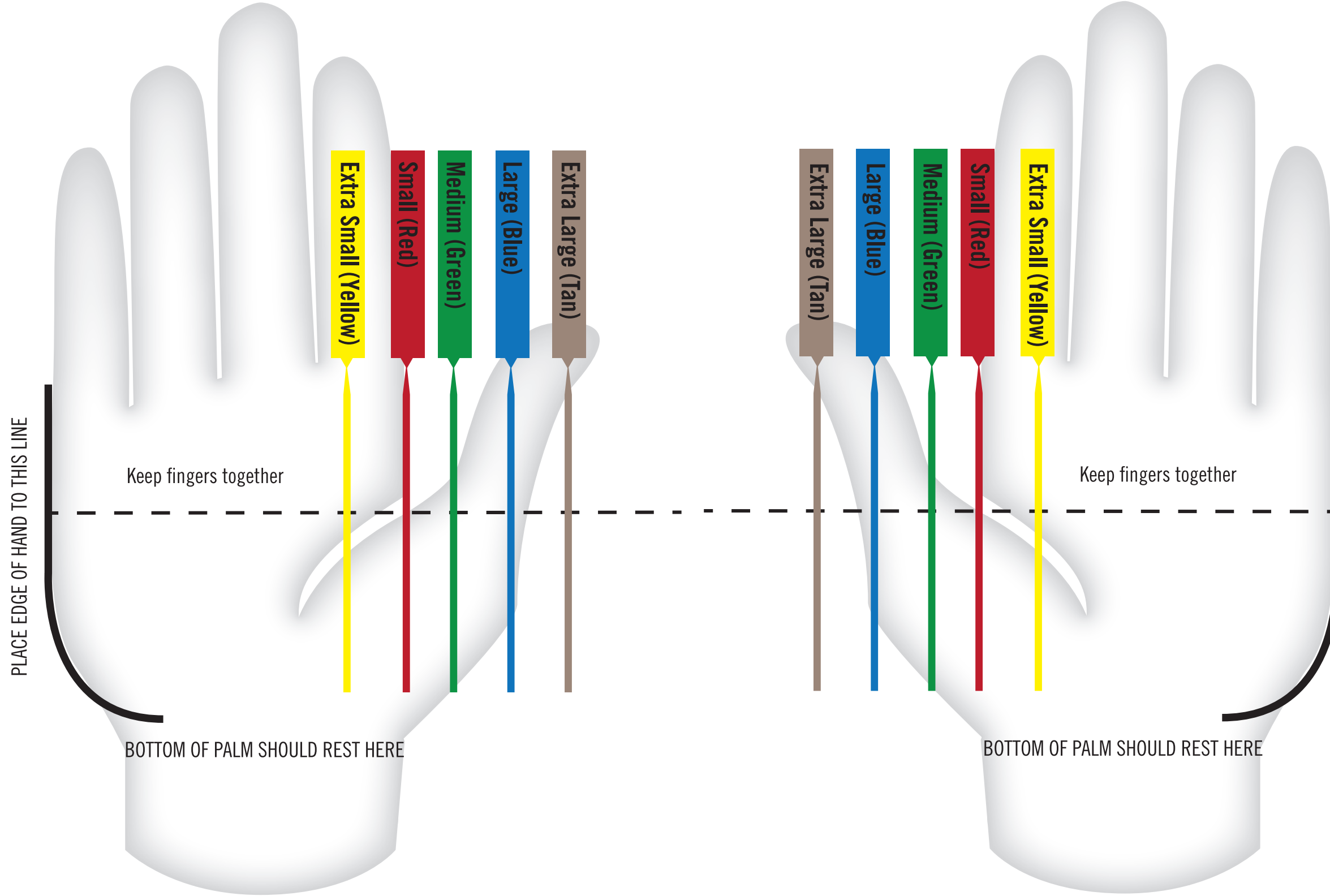


Sizing Guide for Tucker Safety Cut Resistant Gloves

NOTE: Drawing is to scale.



Hands come in all shapes and sizes. A one-size-fits-all approach is simply ineffective. **Correct fit is very important!** It not only reduces risk of injury, but also ensures a longer product life cycle. Workers are also more likely to wear a glove that fits properly and doesn't slow them down.

NOTE: The majority of foodservice workers wear small or medium sizes for proper fit

Gloves should be cleaned and sanitized regularly. (See washing instructions.)



STEP ONE: With fingers together, place hand so that outside of left or right hand and bottom of palm rests on black line.

STEP TWO: Your glove size is determined by the color bar where the index finger side of your hand rests. If your hand falls between bars, select the smaller size.

- Glove should be snug, not tight.
- Fingers should reach completely to the end.
