Use warm soapy cloth or hand to clean exterior and interior surfaces, including seams.



Thoroughly rinse / flush cleaning solution from exterior and interior surfaces. Do NOT soak or submerge for an extended period.



Sanitize all exterior and interior surfaces with sanitizing solution. Follow contact time recommended by manufacturer.
